What the registration fee includes

Tour dates are Wednesday, May 16, through Saturday, May 19, 2018. Getting to Delaware

Wilmington, the largest city in Delaware, is located half an hour south of Philadelphia International Airport (PHL). Delaware Express (<https://delexpress.com/airport-shuttle-service/>, 800.648.5466) provides shuttle van and private car service to PHL and to the more distant Baltimore-Washington International Airport (BWI). All Amtrak trains between Boston and Washington, DC stop at Wilmington; it's a five-minute taxi ride from the station to the Sheraton Wilmington Hotel. (It is also possible to travel from PHL to Wilmington by local train, many Amtrak regional trains stop at BWI airport.) For those who wish to drive, Wilmington is about forty minutes from Philadelphia, and approximately two and a quarter hours from either New York or Washington; be aware that I-95 is subject to heavy traffic and an inordinate number of

accidents and delays. If you plan to arrive early or depart after the tour, we suggest bringing or renting a car or plan to use Uber or another ride service. Taxis, except at Wilmington's Amtrak station and the Hotel Du Pont, are hard to come by, and the public bus service is limited and only understood by regular riders.

The fine print

Enrollment is limited at 50 persons, first come, first served. Slots are expected to fill quickly, so don't delay. If you must cancel, please let us know before April 1, 2018, and we will refund your registration fee in full. After April 1, we will refund as much as possible but may withhold a portion to cover prepaid and fixed expenses. No refunds will be made after May 1. Check-in information and more tour details will be emailed to you in the spring.
